- · Create record of this monthly check

### After Use

- Remove the gas/vapour and/or particulate filters
- Clean with 3M<sup>™</sup> 105 wipe or by immersing in warm cleaning solution, water temperature not to exceed 50°C and scrub with a soft brush until clean
- · Rinse in fresh warm water
- Air dry in a non-contaminated atmosphere


