INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE (HI VIS)

Slide the slits in the neck cape over the rear two clips of the helmets harness to attach to the helmet. Then refit the rear clips into the helmet shell

Make sure the neck cape is in position over the users neck before starting work, in order to provide protection

The hi-vis orange side of the neck cape should be facing outwards when in use



INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE (sun capes)

Attach left rear clip of neck cape around left harness webbing clip, repeat for right side Attach left front clip of neck cape to the side of the sweatband. Repeat for right side When fitting into a helmet with a chinstrap, tuck the neck cape behind the chinstrap anchors

The UPF rating only relates to the areas of skin that the neck cape covers. Protection will only be offered if the helmet and neck cape are fitted and worn correctly
