How does it work?

Polishing floors provides durable protection and gloss. For best results, a good regime of stripping, polishing and maintenance should be adopted.

Strippers, polishes and maintainers are like a family, they work in harmony together. For optimum results, use BioHygiene Floor Maintainer, Floor Stripper and High Gloss Floor Polish.

The problem with adding layer upon layer of polish is that dirt may be locked in until it is stripped back thoroughly. Even if you strip the floor, you may not get underneath all the layers and attack the dirt that was locked in years ago unless you take it all off.

If a floor has been well stripped and sealed, maintenance should be relatively easy. Reapplying polish every couple of months won't be necessary as the maintainer will protect the polish, remove scuff marks, repair scratches and bring back the shine. Two to three coats of polish on the floor will provide a durable, long lasting protected, high gloss finish. The shine can be reactivated using a floor pad on a buffing machine and Biohygiene Floor Maintainer several times a year.

Periodically, BioHygiene Floor Stripper should be used to remove the layers of built up High Gloss Floor Polish and then a fresh protective, durable layer of High Gloss Floor Polish should be reapplied.

Directions for use

For best results apply to a freshly stripped and rinsed floor. Strip old emulsion polish using Biohygiene Floor Stripper. Apply a thin even coat of Biohygiene High Gloss Floor Polish using either a clean mop or polish applicator. Allow to dry thoroughly (typically 20-30 minutes) before applying a second coat. If a higher gloss is required, apply further coats in the same manner. Sweep/dust mop floors daily. For cleaning and gloss maintenance use BioHygiene Floor Maintainer which will protect the gloss on all floors, as well as repairing worn and damaged polish films.
