Description

Features and Benefits

Use Instructions

1. Remove any soiling from surface.
2. Apply the solution directly to surface or with a clean cloth/paper towel and allow contact time depending on dilution.*
 - 1% = 5 minutes (5ml in 500ml)
 - 4% = 30 Seconds (20ml in 500ml)
3. Wipe surface with a clean cloth.
4. Allow to air dry.
5. Diluted solutions should be recharged after 7 days. Wash out bottle before refilling.

Store in original container.

Avoid extremes of temperature.

Product compatibility

Safe to use on most materials found in the food and beverage industries including stainless and galvanised steels, and commonly occurring plastics. Compatibility with other materials should be checked prior to use.

Microbiological Activity

Hospital – Surface Disinfection (Hospitals, medical cabinets)

If a contamination with pathogens is feared or known, high level disinfection or another appropriate measure has to be taken to protect third persons and staff.
